- ***Concert Dress:*** after further democratic consultations it has been decided that the dress code for the April 10th Dvorak Concert is to be:
 - Ladies: black skirts or trousers, black long-sleeved tops.
 - Gentlemen: dinner jackets or dark lounge suits, black bow tie, white shirts.An announcement will be made later as to dress code for Wiesbaden, after consultation with our *Bachchor* friends.
- ***Message from our Treasurer:***
 - A final reminder to anyone whose subs aren't fully paid up: subs are now overdue, so please have a word with Michael (our Treasurer) if you think you might not be up to date.
 - He will be applying to HMRC for our Gift Aid refund soon, so if you pay UK tax and haven't ever completed an RTWCS Gift Aid form, please do so now - forms are available on the table in the foyer.
 - It is timely to give members a further reminder that the Treasurer has announced his firm intention to stand down at the end of the current season. The post will then fall vacant, and will need to be filled at the latest at the September 2011 AGM. All members are therefore again asked to consider whether they, or another member they know, would be suitable and willing to serve in this Office. Michael will be happy to answer any queries you may have about the nature of the post, and any nominations or volunteers should make themselves known to the General Secretary, or to any other Committee Member.
 - Our webmaster Gavin Grant has also requested that if any member would care to offer their services to assist with maintenance of our website, they should please contact him directly.
- ***Message from our Librarian:***
 - Suzie asks that members please get into the habit of returning scores WITHOUT FAIL to her before the concert if they are not singing in it – i.e. at the last rehearsal they attend.
